### CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Hindoien called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

#### APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

# VOTE ON RESOLUTION 904 – SALARIES AND COMPENSATION

# VOTE ON PAY REQUEST NO. 5 – PROSPECT CONSTRUCTION – WATER

#### VOTE ON RESOLUTION – SRF WATER SYSTEM REVENUE BONDS

Council Member Dogiakos made a motion to approve Resolution 905, Council Member Merja seconded the motion. The Motion passed with all those in attendance voting aye.

### DISCUSSION AND VOTE ON NEW CITY CLERK/FINANCE OFFICER

Mayor Hindoien proudly and reluctantly accepted current Finance Officer Rogers resignation effective September 8, 2023. Mayor Hindoien also appointed current Deputy Clerk Tom Frownfelder to replace FO Rogers, with the Councils approval. Council Member Dogiakos made a motion to accept FO Rogers resignation, Council Member Coccoli seconded the motion. The Motion passed with all those in attendance voting aye. Council Member Merja made a motion to appoint the current Deputy Clerk, Tom Frownfelder, to City Clerk/Chief Finance Officer effective September 8, 2023. Council Member Dogiakos seconded the motion. The Motion passed with all those in attendance voting aye.

#### **CLAIMS**

A motion to approve the claims for June and July 2023, Checks #21925-21984, totaling \$1,019,472.47 was made by Council Member Howard. Council Member Dogiakos seconded the motion. The motion passed with all those in attendance voting aye.

# Council Member Coccoli

- Soroptimist Fair went well. Though in the future, she would like parameters for food vendors in the park during their event. She mentioned that the hot air balloons are coming August 18<sup>th</sup>. They are hoping to have 6 balloons total.

# Mayor Hindoien

- Mayor Hindoien said he has not received any complaints on the water project recently. He also gave a brief synopsis on the new flood plain. He will be working closely with DNRC and the county commissioners concerning this matter. He also spoke briefly about the property assessment letters that were sent out to property owners.
